# How Porter County Used TrueRoll to Remove 791 Ineligible Homestead Deductions in Just One Year

## ABOUT

Porter County, Indiana, faced challenges identifying ineligible LLC and rental property deductions after a policy change. Limited staff and technology made improving tax roll accuracy difficult. Partnering with TrueRoll enabled the County Auditor to identify ineligible deductions, manage flagged properties efficiently, and streamline bulk updates.

## HOMESTEAD AUDITING HURDLES

Before implementing TrueRoll's solution, the county faced several Homestead Audit Struggles:

- **Large-Scale Eligibility Changes:** The County had to change the eligibility status for a large number of LLCs and rentals and communicate this news to the county's business owners.
- **Insufficient Technology:** The County's auditing technology could verify a homesteader's primary residence and living status but nothing else. Staff members had to tediously investigate each homestead individually.
- **Limited Time and Staff:** The audit office only has two staff members. Investigating each homestead—one at a time—was impractical, if not impossible.
