# No More Surprises: How Alachua County Prevents Liens and Back Taxes with TrueRoll

## ABOUT

To avoid penalties and back taxes for residents, the Alachua County, FL Property Appraiser's Office partnered with TrueRoll to quickly identify ineligible homesteads before a key staff retirement. What began as a one-time audit evolved into a fully automated, end-to-end homestead administration process.

The office now detects eligibility changes in real time—preventing issues before they occur. After seeing the value of proactive maintenance, they adopted TrueRoll's automated application processing to streamline the entire workflow.

## CHALLENGES

- **Finding Outstanding Ineligible Homesteads Fast:** Facing limited resources, the team needed better tools to quickly find ineligible homesteads and protect residents from penalties.
- **An Audit-Based Approach:** Occasional tax roll audits led to inaccurate exemptions and back tax requests, frustrating residents and damaging trust.
- **Onboarding New Applications:** Manually processing new homestead applications was slow and increased errors. Alachua lacked hiring resources to support this role.

## DRIVING CHANGE

The best part is, the system catches changes like new addresses and rental listings in real-time so Alachua's tax roll remains up-to-date. This allowed officials to contact residents who were eligible for tax deductions but may not have known.
- **Application Vetter:** Alachua adopted Application Vetter to automate homestead exemption application processing, reducing errors and delays. The technology easily integrates with the other software and swiftly provides recommendations for county officials to determine eligibility.

## RESULTS

- **440+ Improper Exemptions Found:** TrueRoll identified hundreds of miscategorized exemptions, including 148 in 2024 alone.
- **\$\$\$3,769,306+ in Recouped Funds:** Identifying improper exemptions led to nearly \$3.8 million in recovered funding.
- **Identification of Eligible Taxpayers:** TrueRoll surfaced unclaimed homesteads for residents who didn't know they qualified and ensured they received the exemptions they deserve.
